


GGWO BALTIMORE • • • • •

•Hungary, Budapest

Jon Cook: Refugees have been swarming into Budapest as they try to escape the trouble in their own countries. We bring them food, clothes, toys, diapers and water.

Pray for the refugees, that we can continue our ministry to them. Also, pray for a blessed school year as I now am in a full-time teaching position. Pray for the youth ministries at GGIS and one in a Korean church down town. God works everything together for good!

Nikki Colby: Recently, we have had the privilege of spending time with some of the migrants who are displaced in Budapest's train stations and parks. Sometimes they invite us to sit on their mats and we spend hours face-to-face with these dear people. Many of them are from Afghanistan and Syria, and have left homes and families in search of a better life. They are in transit (many to Germany), and are "stuck" in Budapest for various reasons. They live in very poor conditions, some totally dependent on charity for their next meal. We share our food, our love, and our joy with them. We show them the "Jesus Movie" in Farsi on our phones and stumble through several languages to make connections. Sometimes we feel the presence of God so strongly, and sometimes we wonder if we are making any difference. Then we see the twinkle in a mother's eye when we say the name "Isa", and we remember that this work is the Lord's. Please pray with us for these families. For safety, provision, and that the seeds that we sow will be watered and take root in their hearts and minds.

Pastor Shane & Bea Richardson: Wednesday evening outreach has been amazing with teenage mime team. Pray for open doors and open hearts as we share the gospel at a metro station near church. God has given us a heart for Brazilians. We thank God for our Brazilian Bible study. Many have come and been touched, encouraged and surprised by God's grace in our meetings. One young Brazilian said that when he came to the Bible study it was the best day in his one and a half years in Hungary. He expressed a desire to go to Bible college. Pray for salvations and disciples among Brazilians; for Luiz who was with us last year and plans to return in January to study at our KETA Bible college; for those who have returned to Brazil and desire to continue growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ.

•Romania

January; Christmas outreach on Dec 18th at the Ambassador School where over 3000 parents will get to hear the gospel; Praise March on Dec 19th with a gospel band and open air preaching in Powai.

Thank you for praying for Pastor Karl and his family. The doctor has said that the disease has stopped progressing. P. Karl does daily exercise and physiotherapy in order to regain muscle strength. Pray for his complete healing, that he could travel in November to visit Gujarat and Nepal. He continues to lead the church and we are seeing resurrection life on display.

Pastor Doug & Beth Pearson: Our focus for church planting is to help lead 3 churches in the slums of Nalasopara in North Mumbai with Pastor Ganesh Wankhede. Mae Sot - Alex Totiensri: Burmese make up most of the population in Mae Sot and they are very open to the gospel.
